Under the guidance of senior auditors, you will assist in conducting financial audits, including:

- Testing and evaluating internal controls and transactions.
- Assessing business processes and performing data analysis.
- Reviewing compliance with policies and legislation.

As part of a collaborative audit team, you'll work with provincial government organizations, adding value and gaining hands-on experience in financial auditing. Limited travel within Nova Scotia may be required.
